Rescue Local and Organic Farming in the Food Safety Bill!

The U.S. Senate will vote shortly on a sweeping overhaul of federal food safety law (S. 510).

The House food safety bill passed last year (HR 2749) included several measures that potentially threaten small-scale local farmers and organic producers, including a blanket application of complicated monitoring and traceability standards

-- regardless of one's farm size — and a potential \$500 fee for any farm engaged in onsite processing (i.e., maple syrup production, sun-dried tomatoes, salad mixes, etc.).

The vast majority of recent food safety scandals in the U.S. — E. coli on fresh spinach, melamine in dairy products, Salmonella in peanut butter — were

all linked to industrial agribusiness practices.

There's no doubt that industrial agriculture and its international supply chain need better oversight, but family-scale local and organic farms are probably the safest in the nation—they are part of the solution, not part of the problem —and need to be protected!

Now is your chance, as a supporter of sustainable family farming, to help fix these problems.

Senator John Tester (D-MT), a certified organic farmer himself, is proposing an amendment to S. 510 that would exempt small-scale farmers and food processors from the most burdensome regulations.
