Sustainable Practices:

All the vineyards I work with are either biodynamic, non-certified organic or sustainable (meaning they do not use herbicides, insecticides or pesticides).

Many also have certifications such as LIVE (Low Impact Viticulture & Ecology) or Salmon Safe.

All vineyard labor in Oregon is union and I have always seen them with proper safety equipment.

Vineyards in the area are also dry-farmed-preserving water and soil.

Geolink Wine is based in Arcata and is committed to seeking out small-production wineries that are family owned or community oriented operations.

As a result, many of the wines are exclusive offerings by Geolink Wine to the northern California community.

We endeavor to explore the relationship between geology and wine. How does the land relate to the characteristics of the wine?

Recognizing the intricate relationship between the land, agricultural methods, and vivifi-

cation practices is important for the overall health of the land and in delivering a quality bottle of wine.

Selling my wine creates cash flow that goes directly back into the local economy as well as back to the families that produce it-no middle corporations or shipping companies.

I import my wine in small batches in a fuel efficient, biodiesel powered vehicle.
