Many of our coffees are shade grown which means they are grown under a canopy of trees. These trees provide a natural habi-

tat for many birds and would otherwise be clear cut to make way for agriculture.

Organic coffee is grown without the use of pesticides or chemical fertilizers, this maintains the integrity of the ground cover and protects nearby rivers from chemical runoff.

Rain Forest Alliance certified coffees benefit plants, animals and ecosystems through soil conservation, reduction of pesticide use for forest preservation and restoration of wildlife migration corridors.

In addition, we support socially conscious organizations that develop community banks, increase access to clean water, carry out health benefit projects and that

help through other endeavors in the coffee growing regions.

Certified Fair Trade Coffees speak directly to the health and welfare of coffee workers.

We have a comprehensive recycling program for our entire company including recycling coffee byproducts into compost and worm beds, diverting plastic bottles and materials for recycling and have been awarded for "The Most Effective Waste Prevention Effort" by Humboldt County.
