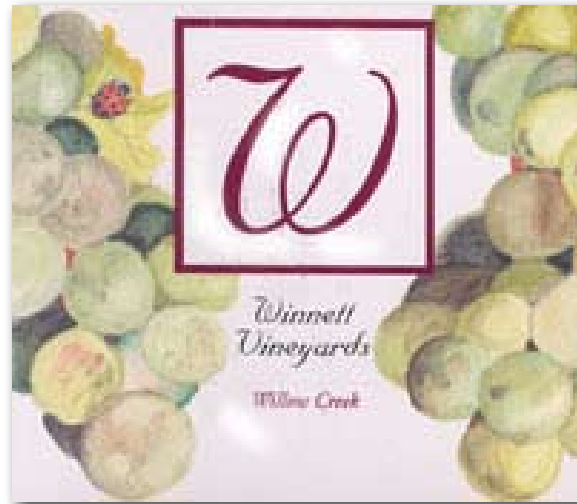

Sustainable Practices:

Winnett Vineyards is located in Willow Creek, growing 100 percent certified organic grapes where we produce wines with minimum sulfates.

We use no pesticides. We spray with only OMRI certified sulfur. We use only OMRI certified fertilizers, (Organic Materials Review Institute (OMRI) provides organic certifiers, growers, manufacturers, and suppliers an independent review of products intended for use in certified organic production, handling, and processing).

We have diversity of crops which include grapes, olives, lavender, garden vegetables and flowers. Thirty percent of

our land is set aside as forest preserve.

Our electricity is produced by solar energy for our home and winery. And our water is heated by a tank-less, on-demand hot water heater.

Our graywater is channelled back in the vineyard for irrigation. Our weed control is mechanical cultivation. Our plant waste is returned to vineyard as compost.

All packaging materials are made from recycled paper or recyclable materials.

Our workforce is comprised of local Willow Creek residents who are paid above prevailing rates according to Federal and California employment practices.
